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# The Madison

## Supplies List

Wonder Clips *or* Double-Sided Tape  
Scissors  
Fabric Marking Pen  
Rotary Cutter and Ruler  
Tex 45 Bonded Nylon Thread  
Size 14 Leather Needle

## Pattern Key

DST – Double-Sided Tape  
WSD – Wrong Side Down  
WST – Wrong Sides Together

**Step 1** – Cut each pattern piece out on the solid lines. Cut a second **Main Body** piece out along the inside dotted line.

**Step 2** – Decide which color faux leather you prefer for the **Main Body**. Cut 1 **Main Body** piece and 1 **Credit Card Slot** piece using the faux leather of choice. Cut 2 **Credit Card Slot** pieces using the accent faux leather. Be sure to place the pattern pieces right side up on the faux leather.

**Step 3** – Using the **Main Body** pattern piece that was cut on the dotted line, cut 1 **Main Body Lining** and 3 **Credit Card Slots** from the adhesive lining. Be sure to follow the instructions indicated on the pattern pieces regarding the number of **Credit Card Slots** to cut from each pattern piece.

**Step 4** – Remove the backing from the **Main Body Lining** and center it on the wrong side of the **Main Body**. Draw a line ½” from each short edge on the wrong side of the **Main Body** piece. Place DST along the short edge, remove the backing from the tape, then fold the short edges down to the line drawn. Wonder Clips can be used in place of DST to hold the folded edges in place.

**Step 5** – Overlap the top angled edge of one of the **Credit Card Slots** with the top angled edge of one of the **Credit Card Slot Lining** pieces. The wrong side of the **Credit Card Slot** piece will be against the right side of the **Credit Card Slot Lining** piece. Hold in place with DST or Wonder Clips. Repeat with the other **Credit Card Slot** pieces.

**Step 6** – Topstitch the short edges of the **Main Body** piece using a 1/8” seam allowance. Topstitch the lining to each **Credit Card Slot** piece along the top angled edges using a 1/8” seam allowance.

**Step 7** – Remove the backing from the **Credit Card Slot Lining** pieces and fold them WST with the **Credit Card Slot** pieces along the stitch lines.

**Step 8** – Join the two short edges of the **Main Body** to find the center point and mark it with a fabric pen on each side. Draw a line across the **Main Body** piece connecting the center points. Measure and draw a second line 3/8” above the first line drawn, then measure and draw a third line 3/8” above the second line drawn.

**Step 9** – Place one of the **Credit Card Slot** pieces in the accent color WSD on the right side of the **Main Body** piece, lining the bottom edge up with the third line drawn (the line closest to the top edge of the **Main Body** piece). Wonder Clip in place, then stitch along the bottom edge of the **Credit Card Slot** using a 1/8” seam allowance.

**Step 10** – Place the **Credit Card Slot** that is the same color as the **Main Body** WSD on the right side of the **Main Body** piece, lining the bottom edge up with the second line drawn (the middle line). Wonder Clip in place, then stitch along the bottom edge of the **Credit Card Slot** using a 1/8” seam allowance.

**Step 11** – Place the final **Credit Card Slot** in the accent color WSD on the right side of the **Main Body** piece, lining the bottom edge up with the first line drawn (the last line available). Wonder Clip in place, then stitch along the bottom edge of the **Credit Card Slot** using a 1/8” seam allowance.

**Step 12** – Fold the **Main Body** in half, WST, matching the short edges and Wonder Clip in place. Starting from the bottom, stitch along both side edges using a 1/4” seam allowance. Test each **Credit Card Slot** to ensure a proper fit. If desired and if space allows, a second vertical seam can be added to the inside of each previously stitched seam, 1/8” from the first.

**Step 13** – Trim the seam allowance to 1/8” on the side edges.

**Congratulations, your Madison is now complete!**
